Dear Dr. Fuchs,

We hope you received our last letter and post card thanking you for the packages sent on November 5th and in early December. Today, I can convey good news to you and our loved ones in the USA that we received a summons from the Marseille consulate for the issuance of a visa. We will now be able to move to the "Les Milles" camp near Marseille (probably within the next 2-3 weeks). For this reason, I would like to request that you not send any planned shipments to us here.
